Sliding Fee Scale Adjustment**

Sliding Fee Scale:

Many Rivers Whole Health (MRWH) offers a sliding fee scale for patients and clients with income under 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. The sliding fee scale is the schedule of discounts offered to self-pay patients. The discounts are based on the federal poverty guidelines adjusted for family size. The federal poverty guidelines are adjusted annually and the scale requires approval from MRWH's CEO. The sliding fee discount program is available based on income and household size.

MRWH's sliding fee scale offers discounts ranging from a full 100% discount for patients and clients with incomes at or less than the amount designated as the poverty level, to a 60% discount for patients with incomes less than two times (200%) the poverty level. After initially being approved for the sliding fee scale program, MRWH will review, update, and recertify eligibility for the SFS on an annual basis.

Examples:

- A client or patient in a family of four (4) with income less than \$27,750 would receive a full 100% discount and pay nothing for care provided at MRWH.

- A client or patient in a family of four (4) with income between \$45,001 and \$52,500 would receive a 70% discount from MRWH's standard charge for the service provided. As an example, if MRWH's charge for the service is \$100, the client or patient pays only \$30 for the service.

Charges:

MRWH's charges are set based on a periodically updated detailed analysis based on a combination of cost, the Medicare fee scale and the Medicaid fee scale. The general philosophical guidance used to set individual charges is to be modestly above the Medicare or Medicaid fee scale amount.
